


TBP Talk #9

TRUSTBUILDING CAMP YOGYAKARTA BATCH 3



Initiatives of Change (IofC) Indonesia bekerja sama dengan Keluarga Mahasiswa Advent Yogyakarta (KMAY) menggelar Trustbuilding Camp batch ke-3. Trustbuilding camp ini berlangsung dari 27 hingga 29 Mei 2022, di Yogyakarta. Mengangkat tema “Heal The Past, Hope for the Future”, camp kali ini hendak mengambil langkah jauh ke depan untuk menatap masa depan bersama dengan memulihkan masa lalu dan menatap harapan di masa depan.

Sesi “Starting With Yourself”:

Lepaskan semua identitas yang melekat pada diri kita selama ini, dan temukan dirimu yang sebenarnya”, ujar Rinni Meir, trainer yang mengajak peserta untuk merenung kalimatnya dalam waktu hening (quiet time). Peserta kemudian saling berbagi sambil mengenal empat basis moral dari Initiatives of Change (IofC) Indonesia yang terdiri dari: kejujuran, ketulusan, ketidakegoisan, dan kasih sayang.



Sesi "Healing Historical Wound":

Peserta dibagi dalam kelompok Kristiani dan Islam dan masing-masing menulis dan mendata apa saja yang dialami komunitas Kristiani dan komunitas Islam

di Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta (DIY) selama kurun sepuluh tahun belakangan, khususnya menyangkut konflik yang mereka rasakan yang menjadi luka di masing-masing komunitas. Setelah mendata rentetan konflik atau luka-luka yang dialami masing-masing komunitas, kedua kelompok saling mempresentasikan hasil temuannya. "Luka-luka itu adalah monumen, tandai baik-baik letak lukanya—and mulailah menyembuhkan luka itu di titik tersebut", ungkap Ahmad Shalahuddin, trainer pada sesi ini.

Sesi "Honest Conversation":

Peserta diajak untuk melakukan simulasi debat dan berdialog. Selain itu, di sesi ini peserta dibagi kelompok sesuai agama, kemudian juga diminta untuk saling menuliskan asumsi serta pertanyaan mereka terhadap agama lain, misalnya komunitas Islam ke komunitas Kristiani, demikian juga sebaliknya. Keseruan terjadi akibat bagaimana masing-masing kelompok membuka ruang dialog tentang asumsi mereka satu sama lain dan mencoba saling mengklarifikasi langsung.

Sesi "Teambuilding":

Selain belajar bagaimana membangun leadership yang adaptif terhadap berbagai perubahan, para peserta juga diajak membangun tim yang solid dan efektif. Membangun tim dimulai dari membangun tim baru sebagai sebuah komunitas dan gerakan yang terus memiliki komitmen belajar satu sama lain.

Friday, 29 July – Sunday, 31 July 2022




The Initiatives of Change (IofC) teams in Indonesia returned to Bandung this year to host another Trustbuilding Camp after hosting the first camp in 2015. The camp brought together young leaders to learn about diversity, building trust, and breaking prejudice, through dialogues, and games such as Friends for Life card game and Pest Attack board game, to create trust and friendship.

“Listening to our inner selves is one the keys to creating change. I have been involved with IofC Indonesia since 2009, which is how I learned about quiet time and learned to practice this daily. We will practice quiet time in this camp together and enjoy the process we make.”

The trustbuilding work is guided by a conceptual framework, which forms the basis for the trustbuilding work of Initiatives of Change International's Trustbuilding Program start with yourself, engage everyone in honest conversation, acknowledge history, and build a diverse team.

The second day's reflection was on starting with self, connecting with others, and to connect with society and find answers to the world's needs. We learned together to connect more with ourselves, to put things right, and take actions for a better life. In this session, we reflected on a question, 'During these weeks, what connections have been made, corrections have been needed and directions to take?'



As the highlight of the camp, we learn to turn reflection into actions. Some participants shared that they were inspired by quiet times. "Being disciplined of having regular quiet times will be one of the actions I will take after the camp," one participant shared. Sonny, facilitator of the Trustbuilding who is also the co-founder of Sekolah Damai Indonesia said, "For me the quiet time session was the highlight of this camp. The reflection impacted positively for me. I will continue to practice quiet time." Another participant shared that he appreciated the spaces given to him to share in the family group. "I feel accepted and listened to. Thank you so much for the safe space."





