The year 2024 marks a decade of the Sekolah Rekonsiliasi's extraordinary journey both in serving the community and the personal growth of each person in it, accompanied by Nandor Lim, from the Akasha Learning Center. This decade-long journey has not been easy. There have been struggles, conflicts, difficulties and hundreds of questions about the existence of the Reconciliation School. But we never doubted the impact that SR has had. We fully welcome the calling to uphold the commitment and strive to be consistent on this path.

Gratitude, reverence and courage are mixed together this year. The system that was updated in 2023 greatly helped our performance and encouraged growth in both the quantity of students and the quality of classes process and facilitators. Our reach has also been expanded through online and offline classes to the northern part of Indonesia, precisely in North Sulawesi.

At the beginning of 2024, the Reconciliation School team was equipped with Team Building and a deeper healing session, how intergenerational trauma greatly affects self-trauma which then affects teamwork. Throughout the year, there were 18 classes and 117 students who studied diligently at SR. At the end of 2024, Sekolah Rekonsiliasi conducted a Healing Journey to Banyuwangi, inviting everyone to greet their inner child, to play and heal together.

We are also grateful for every contribution given in the form of funds, space, effort, thoughts, love, and prayers given so that the good work of Sekolah Rekonsiliasi continues. # Highlighted Activities





## IGCP VIII, Bandung

### January 2024

The collaborative work between lofCID and AKASHA have been established for more than a decade already with working many various programs within the network of lofC regionally. Focusing to this program, it started in 2012 with Inner Growth Program (IGP) In Ciputat, then Inner Growth Companionship Program (IGCP) I 2014 in Lenteng Agung, IGCP II 2015 in Malang, IGCP III 2016 in Bandung, IGCP IV 2018 in Port Dickson, IGCP V 2019 in Bandung, IGCP VI 2020-2021 (online), IGCP VII 2022-2023 (online), IGCP VIII 2023-2024 (online and now).

This training's theme was "Building Team through Working The Inner Work". As an individual in a team, we are facing different challenges in life, so the highlight of this training is we learned about Identity and Roles. After the training, the team has a clearer understanding about Identity and Roles which they want to apply to lofC Indonesia.









## Core Team Annual meeting, Yogyakarta January 2024

Starting the new year in 2024, the core SR team conducted an outreach trip to Yogyakarta. During the visit, they met with the local team and held a strategic meeting to plan for 2024. The outcome of this meeting was a "blueprint" for the next ten years. SR's management structure was reviewed, and explored ways to further develop it. In addition, the team also took time to enjoy Yogyakarta by visiting tourist sites—a chance to relax and recharge before executing the year's plans.



## Akasha's National Consultation Meeting

July 2024

For the first time, the SR team was invited by AKASHA to participate in the 2nd National Consultation Meeting Program.

This event was attended by the working team, the life-teacher assistant team, the 1st volunteer group (Seremban, Negeri Sembilan), the 2nd volunteer group (Butterworth, Penang), the KLSCAH counseling volunteer group, the participants from the AKASHA Learning Circle nationally, and the representatives from IofC Indonesia-School of Reconciliation, 56 participants in total. The eldest was 75-year-old, while the youngest was 31-years-old. Participants came from various places, including Selangor, Penang, Kuala Lumpur, Kedah, Negeri Sembilan, Perak, Johor, and Perlis. At this event, the SR team shared best practices that have been implemented in cities across Indonesia where SR has already made an impact.







# Outreach Program – Play with Inner Child, Banyuwangi

## November 2024

The visit by IofC Indonesia to Banyuwangi, East Java, was an effort by IofC Indonesia to connect with its local team, wrapped in a shared holiday under the theme “Playing with the Inner Child.” Besides strengthening the bond between the local team and the core team, this activity aimed to invite participants to celebrate the child within themselves. It was attended by 26 participants from various regions in Indonesia, ranging from Lampung, Jakarta, Bandung, Jogjakarta, Solo, Madura, and Bali. Even Uncle Peter, a Senior Mentor of IofC Indonesia from Canada, took part in enlivening the entire meaningful holiday experience.

Playing with the Inner Child was a journey to reconnect with nature and each participant’s inner self. We applied three main points from the book “Homecoming,” carried out at the School of Reconciliation. Participants wrote letters using their non-dominant and dominant hands as a means of in-depth healing. In addition, participants came from a wide range of ages, from as young as 7 to as old as 87. They were all encouraged to return to their inner child, to see from a fresh perspective unburdened by the expectations of the adults around them.









# Most Significant Stories of Change

The SR classes made me aware of the wounds of my inner child that I still carry into adulthood. By processing and embracing my emotions, this has quite transformed my relationships with others, especially my parents. I feel more at ease when talking to them, I am not easily triggered like I used to be before I took the SR class, and I can respond more calmly (not reactive). This is the benefit that I feel the most. – one of our support systems, has taken the On The Family and Homecoming classes.

Joining the SR class turned out to be a journey that I didn't expect at all. At first I thought this was just a place to study and have regular discussions, but in the middle I started to feel something different. It turned out that all this time I had a small wound that I had kept for a long time, but I only really realized it when I joined this class.

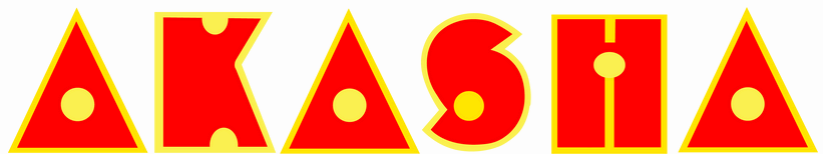
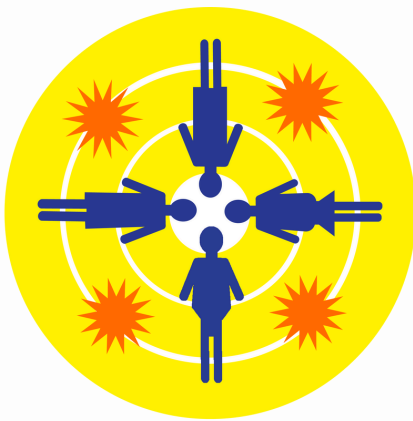
Through the stories and experiences shared, it made me understand more about myself. It was like being given space to stop, think, and slowly accept everything. For me, this class is not only about learning new things, but also a moment for healing. It feels like finding a part of myself that has been lost for a long time. – one of our support systems, has taken the On The Family class.

I know myself much better, have boundaries, sort out and feel emotions in every place (manage emotions) so that it has an impact on physical health, for example, I used to have irregular menstruation, after consulting a doctor, he said that emotional management is important, and SR helped me to manage my emotions and in the past few years, my menstrual cycle can be said to be much more normal.
